



# Providing high density storage for over 11,500 files

## EMAAR – Jeddah, Saudi Arabia

Managing and administrating the new King Abdullah Economic City in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia meant EMAAR needed a filing system to hold in excess of 11,500 files. The area allocated was an archive room adjoining the main Administration Centre. However, it was immediately apparent that a conventional static shelving system could not provide the required storage space. Fortisco's partner in Saudi Arabia, Multi Systems Interior (MSI) working with Fortisco designers, presented a proposal that would almost completely fill the archive room with a long base mechanically assisted mobile shelving system.

The floor panels are supported by mobile rails that form a solid platform that do not require fixing to the existing floor.

For added security when storing the more high profile documents, full height lockable swing doors were fitted to all seven of the static bays.
